Repertoire Requirements

Competitors may only compete in one (1) category of their choice and must play one (1) piece from the repertoire listed for that chosen category and one (1) contrasting piece of their choice. An original, published copy of the music must be presented to the judges at the competition. Memorization is optional for String students. However, memorization is required for Harp students. The teacher/parent assumes responsibility for communicating all information concerning the competition to his/her student/child, and will ensure that entry forms are accurately and completely filled out and mailed by the postmarked deadline.

Eligibility

Participants must be a student on violin, viola, cello, string bass, or harp. Must be of age 16 or younger at the time of competition. Reside and/or take music lessons in central Ohio. Be certified as to performance competency by his/her private string instructor. Have parental approval. Winners from 2010 Young Artist Competition are not eligible to compete in the 2011 competition. Provide own accompanist. *(When possible, accompanists with more than one contestant will be scheduled as close as possible within the same level. If an accompanist's name is not on the entry form, adjacent performances cannot be scheduled. Teachers/parents are responsible for notifying accompanists of the Accompanist Schedule. Accompanists' requests to alter the published schedule will not be honored).* **Entry forms must be postmarked by Friday, December 31, 2010. Late and/or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Teachers/parents must supply copies of all information received to their students/children and accompanists.**
